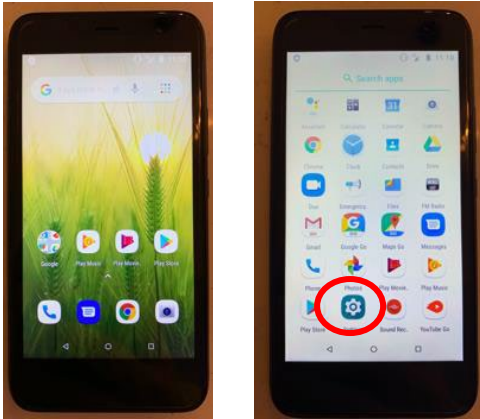
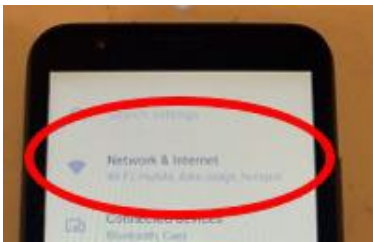


Hotspot set up process

1. Once on the home screen, swipe up on the screen to see all applications. Select the setting icon.



2. In settings, select Network & Internet.



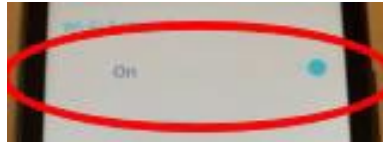
3. In the Network and Internet tab, select Hotspot & tethering.



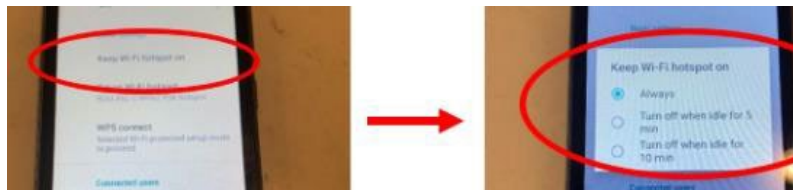
4. Once in the Hotspot & tethering tab, you will see Wi-Fi hotspot.



5. To the right of Wi-Fi Hotspot, you will see a dot. Slide the dot to the right to turn on the Wi-Fi Hotspot.
 - a. When you attempt to slide the dot, you might get a warning message that says: Attention Turning on the Wi-Fi hotspot will disable Wi-Fi activity. Continue? Go ahead and press ok. This just means that your current WiFi connection will turn off as the WiFi on the hotspot connects.
 - b. The dot will turn blue and it will say Poblano is active.

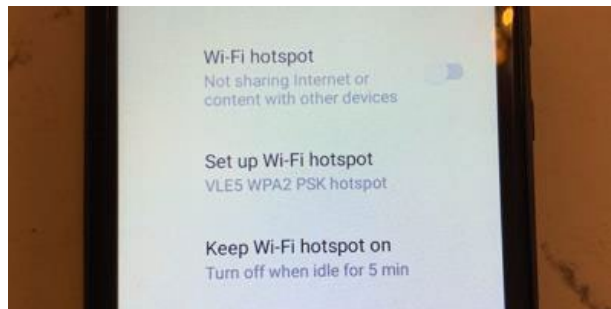


6. Once the WiFi is on, you can choose to keep your hotspot on continuously.
 - a. To do this, go to the Keep Wi-Fi hotspot on (2 down from Wi-Fi hotspot)
 - b. Click on Keep Wi-Fi hotspot on
 - i. 3 options will come up. Choose always.

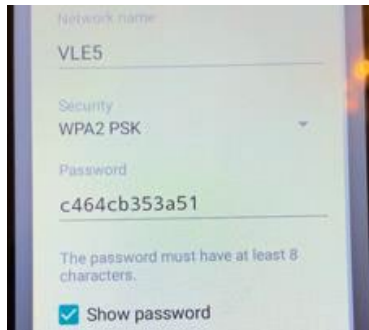


Finding your Network name and Password

1. If you are still in the Hotspot & Tethering tab, then go down to the Setup Wi-Fi hotspot and click on that option.
 - a. If you accidentally exited to the home screen, following the first 3 steps in the above instructions will get you to the Hotspot & tethering tab.



2. You will see a Network name and Password. These are the two things you will need to enter in your laptop settings to connect to the internet.
 - a. If the password is a bunch of dots, click the show password box and the password should appear.



3. You can hit save or cancel to go back to the Hotspot & tethering menu.
4. **Do not change the Network name and password.**
5. To exit to the main screen, click the circle on the bottom of the screen.
